DIRECTOR'S DESK

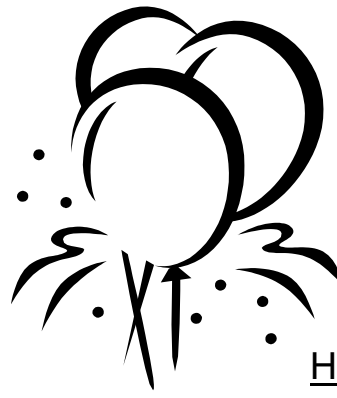
