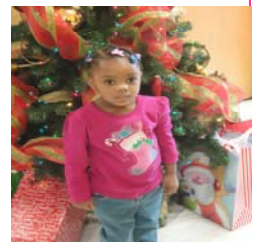

Mary and Etta



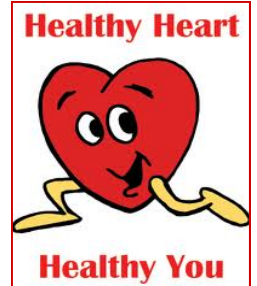

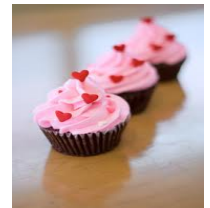
