- 1/2 cup of kraft Italian Dressing

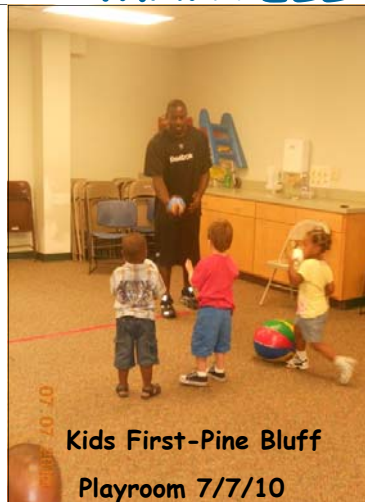


Make it
