Nurturing Idea for September

Play hide-and-seek in the backyard to illustrate how your family is a safe place. Designate a specific point (a tree, shed, etc.) as a "safe" place. When anyone gets to the safe place, he is safe and cannot be caught. Choose one person to be it who will hide his eyes and count to 20. Everyone else should find a hiding place. The object of the game is to get to the safe place. (Let your little ones get to the safe place as often as possible.) After the game, talk to your child about



how good it feels to be in the safe place, and how your family is a safe place for you and your child.
